1 AN ACT concerning liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by adding Section 6-34.5 as follows:
- 6 (235 ILCS 5/6-34.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6-34.5. Powdered alcohol.</u>
- 8 (a) For the purposes of this Section, "powdered alcohol"
- 9 means any powder or crystalline substance containing alcohol,
- 10 <u>as defined in Section 1-3.01 of this Act, produced for human</u>
- 11 consumption.
- 12 <u>(b) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or deliver,</u>
- 13 <u>receive</u>, or purchase for resale in this State any product
- consisting of or containing powdered alcohol.
- (c) Any person who knowingly violates this Section is
- quilty of a Class A misdemeanor for a first offense and a Class
- 4 felony for a second or subsequent offense.
