1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 274

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 274, AS AMENDED, by
3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
6 changing Section 50-30 as follows:

7 (30 ILCS 500/50-30)

8 Sec. 50-30. Revolving door prohibition.

9 (a) Chief procurement officers, State purchasing
10 officers, procurement compliance monitors, their designees
11 whose principal duties are directly related to State
12 procurement, and ~~and~~ executive officers confirmed by the Senate
13 are expressly prohibited for a period of 2 years after
14 terminating an affected position from engaging in any
15 procurement activity relating to the State agency most recently
16 employing them in an affected position for a period of at least

1 6 months. The prohibition includes but is not limited to:
2 lobbying the procurement process; specifying; bidding;
3 proposing bid, proposal, or contract documents; on their own
4 behalf or on behalf of any firm, partnership, association, or
5 corporation. This subsection applies only to persons who
6 terminate an affected position on or after January 15, 1999.

7 (b) In addition to any other provisions of this Code,
8 employment of former State employees is subject to the State
9 Officials and Employees Ethics Act.
