AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 274

AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 274, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following:

"Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by changing Section 50-30 as follows:

- 7 (30 ILCS 500/50-30)
- 8 Sec. 50-30. Revolving door prohibition.
- (a) Chief procurement officers, State purchasing 9 10 officers, procurement compliance monitors, their designees whose principal duties are directly related to State 11 12 procurement, and and executive officers confirmed by the Senate 13 are expressly prohibited for a period of 2 years after terminating an affected position from engaging in 14 15 procurement activity relating to the State agency most recently employing them in an affected position for a period of at least 16

- 1 6 months. The prohibition includes but is not limited to:
- 2 lobbying the procurement process; specifying; bidding;
- 3 proposing bid, proposal, or contract documents; on their own
- 4 behalf or on behalf of any firm, partnership, association, or
- 5 corporation. This subsection applies only to persons who
- 6 terminate an affected position on or after January 15, 1999.
- 7 (b) In addition to any other provisions of this Code,
- 8 employment of former State employees is subject to the State
- 9 Officials and Employees Ethics Act.
