None of the benefits herein 8 provided for shall be paid to any person who is convicted of any felony relating to or arising out of or in connection with 10 his or her service as a member, or any felony relating to or arising out of or in connection with the member holding, at any 11 12 time, any position of trust, authority, or supervision in relation to the victim. 13 This Section shall not operate to impair any contract or 14 15 vested right acquired prior to July 11, 1955 under any law or
