Amend Senate Bill 580, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 3 4 following: 5 "Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental 6 Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by adding Section 7 55.5 as follows: (20 ILCS 1705/55.5 new) 8 Sec. 55.5. Increased wages for front line personnel. The 9 Department shall establish reimbursement rates which build 10 toward livable wages for front line personnel in residential 11 12 and day programs serving persons with intellectual and 13 developmental disabilities under Section 54 of this Act,

including, but not limited to, intermediate care facilities for

persons with developmental disabilities, community-integrated

living arrangements, developmental training programs,

- 1 employment, and other residential and day programs for persons
- with intellectual and developmental disabilities supported by 2
- State funds or funding under Title XIX of the federal Social 3
- 4 Security Act.
- 5 As used in this Section, "front line personnel" means
- 6 direct support persons, aides, front-line supervisors,
- 7 qualified intellectual disabilities professionals, nurses, and
- non-administrative support staff working in service settings 8
- 9 outlined in this Section. The Department shall increase rates
- 10 and reimbursements so that direct support persons earn a base
- 11 wage of not less than \$15 per hour and so that other front line
- 12 personnel earn a commensurate wage.
- 13 Section 10. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 14 adding Section 5-5.4i as follows:
- (305 ILCS 5/5-5.4i new)15
- Sec. 5-5.4i. Increased wages for front line personnel. As 16
- used in this Section, "front line personnel" means direct 17
- 18 support persons, aides, front-line supervisors, qualified
- intellectual disabilities professionals, nurses, and 19
- 20 non-administrative support staff working in service settings
- 21 outlined in this Section.
- 22 Under Section 55.5 of the Mental Health and Developmental
- 23 Disabilities Administrative Act, the payment rate for all
- facilities licensed by the Department of Public Health under 24

- the ID/DD Community Care Act as intermediate care for the 1
- 2 developmentally disabled facilities and under the MC/DD Act as
- 3 medically complex for the developmentally disabled facilities
- 4 shall be increased to fund rates and reimbursements so that
- 5 direct support persons earn a base wage of not less than \$15
- per hour and so that other front line personnel earn a 6
- 7 commensurate wage.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.".
