Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fire Hydrant Act is amended by adding Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (425 ILCS 20/2 new)
- Sec. 2. Recovery of costs; fire hydrant.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "fire hydrant" means a water
 9 hydrant connected to a water supply system installed for the
 10 express purpose of providing water for fire suppression and
 11 that a fire department can connect to and from which it can
 12 pump or draw water. "Fire hydrant" does not include flush
- 13 hydrants.

14 (b) Whoever fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Act within 30 days after written notice of noncompliance 15 16 or violation should reasonably have been received from a fire 17 protection district, township fire department, or municipality in whose jurisdiction a fire hydrant is located, shall be 18 19 responsible for all reasonable costs that the fire protection 20 district, township fire department, or municipality incurs to 21 correct the noncompliance, including attorney's fees and legal 22 expenses incurred by the fire protection district, township

fire department, or municipality in recovering the costs from

- the responsible party. 1
