## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Law Enforcement Information Task Force Act
is amended by changing Sections 20 and 25 as follows:

8 Sec. 20. Preliminary and final report.

9 (a) The Task Force shall provide a preliminary report to 10 the Governor and General Assembly on or before <u>July 15, 2017</u> 11 <del>December 15, 2016</del>, if the final report is not completed by 12 then.

(b) The Task Force shall issue a final report to the Governor and General Assembly on or before <u>October 15</u> January <u>15</u>, 2017. The report shall include recommendations for legislation, use of technology, and other non-legislative processes that would improve the criminal discovery process and law enforcement information sharing.
