2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 1278 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The State Comptroller Act is amended by adding
5	Section 10.05e as follows:
6	(15 ILCS 405/10.05e new)
7	Sec. 10.05e. Deduction from refund for satisfaction of
8	debt.
9	(a) As used in this Section:
10	(1) "Debt" means any amount due and owing under a
11	judgment.
12	(2) "Debtor" means any person or legal entity who owes
13	money to another, if:
14	(A) the debt has been reduced to a judgment in this
15	State; and
16	(B) the judgment has not been:

1	(i) satisfied by court order;
2	(ii) set aside by court order; or
3	(iii) discharged in bankruptcy.
4	(3) "Refund" means a refund of overpaid income taxes
5	imposed by the State of Illinois.
6	(b) If a debtor owes a debt, the judgment creditor may, as
7	provided in this Section:
8	(1) have the Comptroller garnish an unpaid refund
9	payable to the debtor; and
10	(2) have the refund applied against the judgment debt.
11	(c) To obtain a garnishment under this Section, a judgment
12	creditor must obtain a garnishment order, under Part 7 of
13	Article XII of the Code of Civil Procedure, naming the
14	Comptroller as garnishee. The judgment creditor shall provide
15	the garnishment order to the Comptroller.
16	(d) The Comptroller shall deposit the amount available for
17	garnishment under the terms of the order with the judgment
18	attorney of record in the garnishment action, or, if the
19	judgment creditor is not represented by an attorney, with the
20	judgment creditor or the creditor's designee.
21	(e) If 2 or more garnishment orders are received by the
22	Comptroller for the same debtor, the Comptroller shall give
23	priority to the garnishment order that is received first by the
24	Comptroller. The Comptroller shall process each garnishment in
25	order of the date of receipt until the refund of the debtor has
26	been applied in its entirety.

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- qarnishment order under this Section is limited to the amount of the refund due to the debtor for the period the qarnishment order is in effect, less any setoff, counterclaim, or other demand of the State against the debtor. After the Comptroller has deposited the amount available under subsection (d) of this Section, the Comptroller has no further liability in the matter unless:
- 14 <u>(1) a garnishment order is received by the Comptroller</u> 15 for a subsequent tax year; or

 - (3) a refund withholding request to collect any debt owed to the State;
 - (4) a refund withholding request made by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States, or his or her delegate, to collect any tax liability arising from Title 26 of the United States Code;
 - (4.5) a refund withholding request made by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States, or his or her delegate, to collect any nontax debt owed to the United States as authorized under subsection (i-1) of Section 10 of the Illinois State Collection Act of 1986;
 - (4.6) a refund withholding request to collect any debt owed to a unit of local government, school district, or public institution of higher education collected under an intergovernmental agreement entered into under Sections 10.05 and 10.05d of the State Comptroller Act;
 - (5) a refund withholding request pursuant to Section 911.2 of this Act; and
 - (6) a refund withholding request to collect certified
