Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
amended by adding Section 106B-10 as follows:

7 Sec. 106B-10. Conditions for testimony by a victim who is a child or a moderately, severely, or profoundly intellectually 8 9 disabled person or a person affected by a developmental disability. In a prosecution of criminal sexual assault, 10 predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, aggravated 11 criminal sexual assault, criminal sexual abuse, or aggravated 12 criminal sexual abuse, the court may set any conditions it 13 14 finds just and appropriate on the taking of testimony of a victim who is a child under the age of 18 years or a 15 moderately, severely, or profoundly intellectually disabled 16 17 person or a person affected by a developmental disability, involving the use of a facility dog in any proceeding involving 18 19 that offense. When deciding whether to permit the child or 20 person to testify with the assistance of a facility dog, the 21 court shall take into consideration the age of the child or 22 person, the rights of the parties to the litigation, and any other relevant factor that would facilitate the testimony by 23
