Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by adding Sections 22.38a and 22.54b as follows:

- 7 Sec. 22.38a. Limitation on fees assessed by local government on facilities accepting exclusively general 8 9 construction and demolition debris. Except in counties with a population in excess of 1,500,000 residents, a facility 10 regulated under Section 22.38 of this Act shall not be subject 11 to annual fees assessed by a unit of local government and that 12 are directly related to the facility's recycling activities in 13 14 excess of \$2,000.
- 15 (415 ILCS 5/22.54b new)
- Sec. 22.54b. Limitation on fees assessed by local government on facilities that have received a beneficial use determination. Except in counties with a population in excess of 1,500,000 residents, a facility that has received a beneficial use determination from the Agency under Section 22.54 of this Act shall not be subject to annual fees assessed by a unit of local government and that are directly related to

- the facility's recycling activities in excess of \$1,500.
