A home rule unit may not regulate these fees in a manner that is inconsistent with this Section. - 1 determination. Except in counties with a population in excess of 1,500,000 residents, a facility that has received a 2 beneficial use determination from the Agency under Section 3 4 22.54 of this Act shall not be subject to annual fees assessed 5 by a unit of local government and that are directly related to 6 the facility's recycling activities in excess of \$1,500. A home 7 rule unit may not regulate these fees in a manner that is inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a limitation 8 9 under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule 10 11 units of powers and functions exercised by the State.
