2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 1422 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4 5	"Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section 2.5 as follows:
6	(520 ILCS 5/2.5)
7	Sec. 2.5. Crossbow conditions.
8	(a) A person may use a crossbow if one or more of the
9	following conditions are met:
10	(1) the user is a person age 62 and older;
11	(2) the user is a handicapped person to whom the
12	Director has issued a permit to use a crossbow, as provided
13	by administrative rule; or
14	(3) the date of using the crossbow is during the period
15	of the second Monday following the Thanksgiving holiday
16	through the last day of the archery deer hunting season

- 1 (both inclusive) set annually by the Director.
- 2 <u>(b)</u> As used in this Section, "handicapped person" means a
- 3 person who has a physical impairment due to injury or disease,
- 4 congenital or acquired, which renders the person them so
- 5 severely disabled as to be unable to use a longbow, recurve
- 6 bow, or compound bow. Permits must be issued only after the
- 7 receipt of a physician's statement confirming the applicant is
- 8 handicapped as defined above.
- 9 (c) A person may use a crossbow to take coyotes at any time
- that it is legal to use a bow and arrow to take coyotes.
