SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/7-1-10.5 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that before a municipality uses territory annexed under to this Division for sand, rock, or gravel mining operations, the municipality must have approval of all township boards of trustees, by a majority vote of each board, whose township has jurisdiction over all or part of a highway or road within 20 miles of the annexed territory. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
5 Section 7-1-10.5 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/7-1-10.5 new)

7 Sec. 7-1-10.5. Approval of township board. Before a
8 municipality uses territory annexed under to this Division for
9 sand, rock, or gravel mining operations, the municipality must
10 have approval of all township boards of trustees, by a majority
11 vote of each board, whose township has jurisdiction over all or
12 part of a highway or road within 20 miles of the annexed
13 territory.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
15 becoming law.
