

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing the
5 heading of Article Div. 5-5 and by adding Section 5-5002 as
6 follows:

7 (55 ILCS 5/Div. 5-5 heading)

8 Division 5-5. Contracts for Police Protection
9 and Fire Protection

10 (55 ILCS 5/5-5002 new)

11 Sec. 5-5002. Identification of nongovernmental contracted
12 fire protection services.

13 (a) For purposes of this Section:

14 "Conspicuously display" means to display a disclosure that
15 is at least the same size as and located close to the largest
16 logo referring to the county.

17 "Logo" means a symbol, graphic, seal, emblem, insignia,
18 trade name, brand name, picture, or text identifying a person,
19 firm, corporation, association, or county.

20 "Occurrence" means each vehicle or uniform in violation of
21 this Section that could be viewed by members of the public that
22 fails to display the required disclosure consistent with the

1 provisions of this Section.

2 (b) Any nongovernmental entities that the county board
3 contracts with to furnish fire protection services that display
4 a logo of the county on the entity's vehicle or uniform shall
5 also conspicuously display on all vehicles and uniforms the
6 following disclosure:

7 (1) A statement indicating that the entity is the
8 service provider, contractor, or other appropriate
9 descriptor, with substantially similar language of
10 "SERVICE PROVIDED BY:" or "CONTRACTED BY:";

11 (2) The name of the contracting person, firm,
12 corporation, or association that is providing the labor or
13 services for the county;

14 (3) The state or federal tax designation of the
15 contracting person, firm, corporation, or association; and

16 (4) The entity's principal place of business as
17 disclosed in the entity's records with the Secretary of
18 State or other similar agency outside of Illinois.

19 If a vehicle or uniform displays more than one logo referring
20 to the county, then the required disclosure shall be placed
21 near the largest logo referring to the county.

22 (c) A person or entity that violates this Section is guilty
23 of a business offense and shall be fined \$1,000 per occurrence.
24 The circuit court in the county where a violation occurs shall
25 have jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Section.

26 (d) A home rule unit may not regulate in a manner

1 inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a limitation
2 under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the
3 Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule
4 units of powers and functions exercised by the State.

5 Section 10. The Township Code is amended by adding Section
6 200-20 as follows:

7 (60 ILCS 1/200-20 new)

8 Sec. 200-20. Identification of nongovernmental contracted
9 fire protection services.

10 (a) For purposes of this Section:

11 "Conspicuously display" means to display a disclosure that
12 is at least the same size as and located close to the largest
13 logo referring to the township.

14 "Logo" means a symbol, graphic, seal, emblem, insignia,
15 trade name, brand name, picture, or text identifying a person,
16 firm, corporation, association, or township.

17 "Occurrence" means each vehicle or uniform in violation of
18 this Section that could be viewed by members of the public that
19 fails to display the required disclosure consistent with the
20 provisions of this Section.

21 (b) Any nongovernmental entities that the governing body of
22 a township contracts with to furnish fire protection services
23 that display a logo of a township on the entity's vehicle or
24 uniform shall also conspicuously display on all vehicles and

1 uniforms the following disclosure:

2 (1) A statement indicating that the entity is the
3 service provider, contractor, or other appropriate
4 descriptor, with substantially similar language of
5 "SERVICE PROVIDED BY:" or "CONTRACTED BY:";

6 (2) The name of the contracting person, firm,
7 corporation, or association that is providing the labor or
8 services for the township;

9 (3) The state or federal tax designation of the
10 contracting person, firm, corporation, or association; and

11 (4) The entity's principal place of business as
12 disclosed in the entity's records with the Secretary of
13 State or other similar agency outside of Illinois.

14 If a vehicle or uniform displays more than one logo referring
15 to the township, then the required disclosure shall be placed
16 near the largest logo referring to the township.

17 (c) A person or entity that violates this Section is guilty
18 of a business offense and shall be fined \$1,000 per occurrence.
19 The circuit court in the county where a violation occurs shall
20 have jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Section.

21 (d) A home rule unit may not regulate in a manner
22 inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a limitation
23 under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the
24 Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule
25 units of powers and functions exercised by the State.

1 Section 15. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
2 adding Section 11-6-8 as follows:

3 (65 ILCS 5/11-6-8 new)

4 Sec. 11-6-8. Identification of nongovernmental contracted
5 fire protection services.

6 (a) For purposes of this Section:

7 "Conspicuously display" means to display a disclosure that
8 is at least the same size as and located close to the largest
9 logo referring to the municipality.

10 "Logo" means a symbol, graphic, seal, emblem, insignia,
11 trade name, brand name, picture, or text identifying a person,
12 firm, corporation, association, or municipality.

13 "Occurrence" means each vehicle or uniform in violation of
14 this Section that could be viewed by members of the public that
15 fails to display the required disclosure consistent with the
16 provisions of this Section.

17 (b) Any nongovernmental entities that the corporate
18 authorities of any municipality contracts with to furnish fire
19 protection services that display a logo of a municipality on
20 the entity's vehicle or uniform shall also conspicuously
21 display on all vehicles and uniforms the following disclosure:

22 (1) A statement indicating that the entity is the
23 service provider, contractor, or other appropriate
24 descriptor, with substantially similar language of
25 "SERVICE PROVIDED BY:" or "CONTRACTED BY:";

1 (2) The name of the contracting person, firm,
2 corporation, or association that is providing the labor or
3 services for the municipality;

4 (3) The state or federal tax designation of the
5 contracting person, firm, corporation, or association; and

6 (4) The entity's principal place of business as
7 disclosed in the entity's records with the Secretary of
8 State or other similar agency outside of Illinois.

9 If a vehicle or uniform displays more than one logo referring
10 to the municipality, then the required disclosure shall be
11 placed near the largest logo referring to the municipality.

12 (c) A person or entity that violates this Section is guilty
13 of a business offense and shall be fined \$1,000 per occurrence.
14 The circuit court in the county where a violation occurs shall
15 have jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this Section.

21 Section 20. The Fire Protection District Act is amended by
22 adding Section 11a-5 as follows:

24 Sec. 11a-5. Identification of nongovernmental contracted

1 fire protection services.

2 (a) For purposes of this Section:

3 "Conspicuously display" means to display a disclosure that
4 is at least the same size as and located close to the largest
5 logo referring to the district.

6 "Logo" means a symbol, graphic, seal, emblem, insignia,
7 trade name, brand name, picture, or text identifying a person,
8 firm, corporation, association, or district.

9 "Occurrence" means each vehicle or uniform in violation of
10 this Section that could be viewed by members of the public that
11 fails to display the required disclosure consistent with the
12 provisions of this Section.

13 (b) Any nongovernmental entities that the Board of Trustees
14 contracts with to furnish fire protection services pursuant to
15 Section 11a that display a logo of a district on the entity's
16 vehicle or uniform shall also conspicuously display on all
17 vehicles and uniforms the following disclosure:

18 (1) A statement indicating that the entity is the
19 service provider, contractor, or other appropriate
20 descriptor, with substantially similar language of
21 "SERVICE PROVIDED BY:" or "CONTRACTED BY:";

22 (2) The name of the contracting person, firm,
23 corporation, or association that is providing the labor or
24 services for the district;

25 (3) The state or federal tax designation of the
26 contracting person, firm, corporation, or association; and

1 (4) The entity's principal place of business as
2 disclosed in the entity's records with the Secretary of
3 State or other similar agency outside of Illinois.

4 If a vehicle or uniform displays more than one logo referring
5 to the district, then the required disclosure shall be placed
6 near the largest logo referring to the district.

7 (c) A person or entity that violates this Section is guilty
8 of a business offense and shall be fined \$1,000 per occurrence.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
17 becoming law.
