1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1582

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1582 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Section 11-1414.1 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1414.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1414.1)

7 Sec. 11-1414.1. School transportation of students.

8 (a) Every student enrolled in grade 12 or below in any
9 entity listed in subsection (a) of Section 1-182 of this Code
10 must be transported in a school bus or a vehicle described in
11 subdivision (1) or (2) of subsection (b) of Section 1-182 of
12 this Code for any curriculum-related school activity, except a
13 student in any of grades 9 through 12 or a student in any of
14 grades K though 12 with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
15 with a staff to student ratio of 1 to 5, and attending Acacia
16 Academy, Alexander Leigh, Marklund, Helping Hands Center,

1 South Campus, New Connections Academy, Connections Day School,
2 Connections Academy East, Virtual Connections Academy,
3 Transitions School, New Horizon Academy, or The Hope Institute
4 for Children and Families may be transported in a
5 multi-function school activity bus (MFSAB) as defined in
6 Section 1-148.3a-5 of this Code for any curriculum-related
7 activity except for transportation on regular bus routes from
8 home to school or from school to home, subject to the following
9 conditions:

10 (i) A MFSAB may not be used to transport students under
11 this Section unless the driver holds a valid school bus
12 driver permit.

13 (ii) The use of a MFSAB under this Section is subject
14 to the requirements of Sections 6-106.11, 6-106.12,
15 12-707.01, 13-101, and 13-109 of this Code.

16 "Curriculum-related school activity" as used in this
17 subsection (a) includes transportation from home to school or
18 from school to home, tripper or shuttle service between school
19 attendance centers, transportation to a vocational or career
20 center or other trade-skill development site or a regional safe
21 school or other school-sponsored alternative learning program,
22 or a trip that is directly related to the regular curriculum of
23 a student for which he or she earns credit.

24 (b) Every student enrolled in grade 12 or below in any
25 entity listed in subsection (a) of Section 1-182 of this Code
26 who is transported in a vehicle that is being operated by or

1 for a public or private primary or secondary school, including
2 any primary or secondary school operated by a religious
3 institution, for an interscholastic, interscholastic-athletic,
4 or school-sponsored, noncurriculum-related activity that (i)
5 does not require student participation as part of the
6 educational services of the entity and (ii) is not associated
7 with the students' regular class-for-credit schedule shall
8 transport students only in a school bus or vehicle described in
9 subsection (b) of Section 1-182 of this Code. This subsection
10 (b) does not apply to any second division vehicle used by an
11 entity listed in subsection (a) of Section 1-182 of this Code
12 for a parade, homecoming, or a similar noncurriculum-related
13 school activity.
