Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding 4 5 Section 8-201.6 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 8-201.6. Waiver of deposit; victims of domestic violence. For the purposes of this Section, "domestic violence" 8 9 means abuse by a family or household member, as "abuse" and "family or household members" are defined in Section 103 of the 10 Illinois Domestic Violence Act of 1986.
- 12 A utility shall waive the utility's initial credit and deposit requirements for a period of 60 days for a residential 13 14 customer or applicant who is a victim of domestic violence. To be eligible for the waiver under this Section, the domestic 15 16 violence must be certified by treating medical personnel, law 17 enforcement personnel, a State's Attorney, the Attorney General, or a domestic violence shelter. The certification 18 19 letter must be printed on the certifying entity's letterhead or 20 accompanied by a letter on the certifying entity's letterhead 21 that identifies the certifying individual.
