1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1906

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1906 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Sections 5.866 and 5.867 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.866 new)

7 Sec. 5.866. The U.S.S. Illinois Commissioning Fund. This
8 Section is repealed on December 31, 2017.

9 (30 ILCS 105/5.867 new)

10 Sec. 5.867. The Autism Care Fund.

11 Section 10. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by
12 adding Section 507DDD, 507EEE, and 507FFF as follows:

13 (35 ILCS 5/507DDD new)

1 Sec. 507DDD. Special Olympics Illinois and Special
2 Children's Checkoff. For taxable years beginning on or after
3 January 1, 2015, the Department shall print on its standard
4 individual income tax form a provision indicating that if the
5 taxpayer wishes to contribute to the Special Olympics Illinois
6 and Special Children's Charities Checkoff Fund as authorized by
7 this amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly, he or she may
8 do so by stating the amount of the contribution (not less than
9 \$1) on the return and that the contribution will reduce the
10 taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment to
11 accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased
12 payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly. This
13 Section shall not apply to an amended return. For the purpose
14 of this Section, the Department of Revenue must distribute the
15 moneys as provided in 21.9(b) of the Illinois Lottery Law: (i)
16 75% of the moneys to Special Olympics Illinois to support the
17 statewide training, competitions, and programs for future
18 Special Olympics athletes; and (ii) 25% of the moneys to
19 Special Children's Charities to support the City of
20 Chicago-wide training, competitions, and programs for future
21 Special Olympics athletes.

22 (35 ILCS 5/507EEE new)

23 Sec. 507EEE. U.S.S. Illinois Commissioning Fund checkoff.
24 For taxable years ending on or after December 31, 2014 and
25 ending on or before December 31, 2016, the Department must

1 print on its standard individual income tax form a provision
2 (i) indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the
3 U.S.S. Illinois Commissioning Fund, a special fund created in
4 the State treasury, for the purpose of donating to the U.S.S.
5 Illinois Commissioning Committee, as authorized by this
6 amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly, he or she may do
7 so by stating the amount of the contribution (not less than \$1)
8 on the return and (ii) stating that the contribution will
9 reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment
10 to accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of
11 increased payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly.
12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, moneys deposited
13 into the U.S.S. Illinois Commissioning Fund from contributions
14 under this Section shall be used by the Department of Military
15 Affairs to make grants to the U.S.S. Illinois Commissioning
16 Committee. This Section does not apply to any amended return.

17 This Section is repealed on December 31, 2017.

18 (35 ILCS 5/507FFF new)

19 Sec. 507FFF. Autism Care Fund checkoff. For taxable years
20 ending on or after December 31, 2015, the Department must print
21 on its standard individual income tax form a provision (i)
22 indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the
23 Autism Care Fund, a special fund created in the State treasury,
24 for the purpose of donating to the Autism Society of Illinois,
25 as authorized by this amendatory Act of the 99th General

1 Assembly, he or she may do so by stating the amount of the
2 contribution (not less than \$1) on the return and (ii) stating
3 that the contribution will reduce the taxpayer's refund or
4 increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure
5 to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the
6 contribution accordingly. Notwithstanding any other provision
7 of law, moneys deposited into the Autism Care Fund from
8 contributions under this Section shall be used by the
9 Department of Human Services to make grants to the Autism
10 Society of Illinois. This Section does not apply to any amended
11 return.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
13 becoming law.".
