- Section 20. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its administrative costs and for grants to emergency

Section 35. The sum of \$4,240,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for administrative expenses.

Section 40. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much of thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Commerce Commission from the Illinois Power Agency Renewable Resources Fund for deposit into the Public Utility Fund.

- 1 Section 45. No contract shall be entered into or
- 2 obligation incurred or any expenditure made from the
- 3 appropriation herein made in Section 40 of this Article until
- 4 after the purpose and the amount of such expenditure has been
- 5 approved in writing by the Governor.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 7 2015.
