A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. "Operational expenses" defined. For the  
6 purposes of this Act, the term "operational expenses"  
7 includes the following items:

- 8 (a) Personal Services;
- 9 (b) State contributions to Social Security
- 10 (c) Group Insurances;
- 11 (d) Contractual Services
- 12 (e) Travel;
- 13 (f) Commodities;
- 14 (g) Printing;
- 15 (h) Equipment;
- 16 (i) Electronic data processing;
- 17 (j) Telecommunications services;
- 18 (k) Operation of automotive equipment;
- 19 (l) Refunds;
- 20 (m) Employee retirement contributions paid by the employer;
- 21 (n) Permanent improvements;
- 22 (o) Deposits to other funds.

1           Section 5. The sum of \$373,254,500, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
3 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant  
4 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program,  
5 as provided by law, and for administrative costs not to  
6 exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in this Section.

7           Section 10. In addition to other amounts appropriated,  
8 the amount of \$7,673,800, or so much thereof as may be  
9 necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance Fund  
10 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for grants and  
11 administrative expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
12 2016.

13           Section 15. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
15 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
16 for costs associated with the Veterans' Home Nurses' Loan  
17 Repayment Program pursuant to Public Act 95-0576.

18           Section 20. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISAC Accounts  
20 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
21 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent

1 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection  
2 Act of 1986.

3 Section 25. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
5 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for  
6 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate  
7 Program, as provided by law.

8 Section 30. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
10 Student Assistance Commission Contracts and Grants Fund to  
11 the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following  
12 purpose:

13 To support outreach, research, and  
14 training activities .....10,000,000

15 Section 35. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Optometric  
17 Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the Illinois Student  
18 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

19 Grants and Scholarships  
20 For payment of scholarships for the  
21 Optometric Education Scholarship  
22 Program, as provided by law .....50,000

1 Section 40. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the National Guard  
 3 and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the Illinois Student  
 4 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

5 Grants and Scholarships

6 For payment of Illinois National Guard and  
 7 Naval Militia Scholarships  
 8 at State-controlled universities  
 9 and public community colleges in  
 10 Illinois to students eligible to  
 11 receive such awards, as provided by law .....20,000

12 Section 45. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as  
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Golden Apple  
 14 Scholars of Illinois Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 15 Commission for the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Program,  
 16 as provided by law.

17 Section 50. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 18 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
 19 Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the Student Loan  
 20 Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent expenses:

15       Section 55. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
17 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund  
18 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and  
19 Maintenance.

20       Section 60. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof  
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
22 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund  
23 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment

1 of collection agency fees associated with collection  
 2 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default  
 3 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary  
 4 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

5 Section 65. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
 7 Congressional Teacher Scholarship Program Fund to the  
 8 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following  
 9 purpose:

10 For transferring repayment funds collected  
 11 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship  
 12 Program to the U.S. Treasury .....400,000

13 Section 70. The sum of \$261,000,000, or so much thereof  
 14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
 15 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for  
 16 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for  
 17 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection  
 18 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under  
 19 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for  
 20 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default  
 21 Aversion Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for  
 22 other distributions as necessary and provided for under the  
 23 Federal Higher Education Act.

1           Section 75. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
3 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
4 Commission for payment of grants for the Federal College  
5 Access Challenge Grant Program, with up to six percent of the  
6 funding appropriated to meet allowable administrative costs,  
7 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act (CCRAA),  
8 as provided by law.

9           Section 80. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
11 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
12 Commission for the John R. Justice Student Loan Repayment  
13 Program.

14           Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
15 2015.
