1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2029

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2029 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$33,512,100 or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education  
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State  
8 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Chicago State  
12 University Education Improvement Fund to the Board of  
13 Trustees of Chicago State University for any expenses

1 incurred by the university.

2 Section 15. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
4 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
5 Chicago State University for costs associated with the  
6 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice  
7 education or training programs.

8 Section 20. The sum of \$488,800, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
10 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State  
11 University as a grant to the Financial Assistance Outreach  
12 Center.

13 ARTICLE 2

14 Section 5. The sum of \$22,498,000 or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary is appropriated from the Education  
16 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Governors State  
17 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

19 ARTICLE 3

Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and contingent expenses:

For Personal Services .....	1,094,700
For State Contributions to Social	
Security, for Medicare .....	15,100
For Contractual Services .....	278,600
For Travel .....	36,700

Section 10. The sum of \$958,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to Illinois Community College Board for costs associated with administering high school equivalency tests.

Section 15. The sum of \$6,794,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to  
2 the alternative schools network.

3 Section 20. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
5 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and  
6 Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered  
7 Nurse Preparation.

8 Section 25. The sum of \$60,200, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
10 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding  
11 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's  
12 Challenge Program.

13 Section 30. The sum of \$13,762,200, or so much thereof  
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City  
16 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

17 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
19 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community  
20 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
21 colleges for the purposes specified:

1	Small College Grants .....	537,600
2	Retirees Health Insurance Grants .....	0
3	Workforce Development Grants .....	0

6       Section 40. The sum of \$148,400, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
9 associated with the development, support or administration of  
10 the Illinois Longitudinal Data System.

11       Section 45. The sum of \$1,457,900, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
13 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to  
14 operate the East St. Louis Community College Center.

15       Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
17 Community College Board for all costs associated with career  
18 and technical education activities:

19	From the General Revenue Fund .....	17,569,400
20	From the Career and Technical Education Fund .....	<u>18,500,000</u>

1       Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much of  
2 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and  
3 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community  
4 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

5 From the General Revenue Fund:

6       For payment of costs associated  
7       with education and educational-related  
8       services to local eligible providers  
9       for adult education and  
10      literacy .....21,572,400

11      For payment of costs associated  
12      with education and educational-related  
13      services to local eligible providers  
14      for performance-based awards .....10,701,600

15      For operational expenses of and  
16      for payment of costs associated with  
17      education and educational-related  
18      services to recipients of Public  
19      Assistance, and, if any funds remain,  
20      for costs associated with  
21      education and educational-related  
22      services to local eligible providers  
23      for adult education and literacy .....0

24 From the ICCB Adult Education Fund:

25      For payment of costs associated with

1 education and educational-related  
2 services to local eligible providers  
3 and to Support Leadership Activities,  
4 as Defined by U.S.D.O.E.  
5 for adult education and literacy  
6 as provided by the United States  
7 Department of Education .....23,250,000

9 Section 60. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the  
11 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College  
12 Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
13 colleges for the purposes specified:

14 Base Operating Grants .....186,968,300  
15 Equalization Grants .....73,870,500  
16 Total \$260,838,800

17 Section 65. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional  
19 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to  
20 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated  
21 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

22 Section 70. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the High School  
2 Equivalency Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College  
3 Board for costs associated with administering high school  
4 equivalency tests.

5 Section 75. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
7 Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the  
8 Illinois Community College Board to be expended under the  
9 terms and conditions associated with the moneys being  
10 received, including prior year expenditures.

11 Section 80. The sum of \$480,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust  
13 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and  
14 contingency expenses of the Board.

15 Section 85. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult  
17 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for  
18 operational expenses associated with administration of adult  
19 education and literacy activities.

20 Section 90. The sum of \$391,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue



Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for a grant to Rock Valley College for programs for transitioning high school students.

Section 95. The sum of \$1,259,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse the following colleges for costs associated with the Illinois Veterans' Grant:

9 Illinois University for ordinary and contingent expenses for  
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

11 ARTICLE 999

12 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
13 1, 2015.".
