2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2039, by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
6 as are available for distribution in accordance with Section 8  
7 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor Fuel  
8 Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the purposes  
9 stated:

4 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund  
6 to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local  
7 governments for admissions and wagering tax, including prior  
8 year costs.

9 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery  
11 Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes to  
12 holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes  
13 related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of  
14 promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of  
15 lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois  
16 Lottery Law.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
19 Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service  
20 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911  
21 Administrator Program.

1 Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof  
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1  
 3 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to  
 4 the Emergency Telephone System Act.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof  
 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service  
 7 Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its  
 8 administrative costs and for grants to emergency telephone  
 9 system boards, qualified government entities, or the Department  
 10 of State Police for the design, implementation, operation,  
 11 maintenance, or upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency  
 12 services and public safety answering points.

13 Section 35. The following named sums, or so much thereof

3 Section 40. The amount of \$2,081,300, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Pensions

4 Section 265. The sum of \$90,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the  
6 Secretary of State from the Illinois Police Association Fund  
7 for providing death benefits for the families of police  
8 officers killed in the line of duty, and for providing  
9 scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or both,  
10 to children and spouses of police officers killed in the line  
11 of duty.

12 Section 270. The sum of \$35,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
14 from the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for grants  
15 to the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for  
16 religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational  
17 purposes.

18 Section 275. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be  
19 necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of  
20 State from the 4-H Fund for grants to the Illinois 4-H  
21 foundation for the purpose of funding 4-H programs in Illinois.

1 Section 280. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the  
3 Secretary of State from the Fraternal Order of Police Fund for  
4 grants to the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police to increase  
5 the efficiency and professionalism of law enforcement officers  
6 in Illinois, to educate the public about law enforcement  
7 issues, to more firmly establish the public confidence in law  
8 enforcement, to create partnerships with the public, and to  
9 honor the service of law enforcement officers.

10 Section 285. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
12 from the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of  
13 Illinois Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for  
14 educational programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how  
15 to legally and more safely share the roadways.

16 Section 290. The sum of \$3,500, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the  
18 Secretary of State from the St. Jude Children's Research Fund  
19 for grants to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital for  
20 pediatric treatment and research.

21 Section 295. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the

1 Secretary of State from the Ducks Unlimited Fund for grants to  
2 Ducks Unlimited, Inc. to fund wetland protection, enhancement,  
3 and restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund  
4 education and outreach for media, volunteers, members, and the  
5 general public regarding waterfowl and wetlands conservation in  
6 the State of Illinois, and to cover reasonable cost for Ducks  
7 Unlimited plate advertising and administration of the wetland  
8 conservation projects and education program.

9 Section 300. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
11 from the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs associated  
12 with enforcement of the Family Financial Responsibility Law.

13 Section 305. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be  
14 necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of  
15 State from the Soil and Water Conservation District Fund for  
16 grants to Illinois soil and water conservation districts for  
17 projects that conserve and restore soil and water in Illinois.

18 Section 310. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may  
19 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of  
20 State from the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund for  
21 grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation, Inc.  
22 for building and maintaining a memorial and park, holding an

1 annual memorial commemoration, giving scholarships to children  
2 of State police officers killed or catastrophically injured in  
3 the line of duty, and providing financial assistance to police  
4 officers and their families when a police officer is killed or  
5 injured in the line of duty.

6 Section 315. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may  
7 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of  
8 State from the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Scholarship and  
9 Training Fund for grants to the Illinois Sheriffs' Association  
10 for scholarships obtained in a competitive process to attend  
11 the Illinois Teen Institute or an accredited college or  
12 university, for programs designed to benefit the elderly and  
13 teens, and for law enforcement training.

#### ARTICLE 8

15 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may  
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller from  
17 the Comptroller's Administrative Fund for the discharge of  
18 duties of the office.

#### ARTICLE 998

20 Section 5. The appropriation authority granted in this

1 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through June  
2 30, 2016.

3 ARTICLE 999

4 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
5 becoming law.".
