

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$8,120,500, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Supreme Court for probation reimbursements,  
8 including reimbursement for Sex Offender GPS tracking.

9 Section 10. This Article shall not be effective if SB  
10 2035 of the 99<sup>th</sup> General Assembly becomes law.

11 ARTICLE 2

12 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department on Aging  
14 for the Community Care Program:
