1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2043

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2043, by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The sum of \$397,073,100, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
8 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant
9 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program,
10 as provided by law, and for agency administrative and
11 operational costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total
12 appropriation in this Section.

13 Section 10. The sum of \$274,601,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
2 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
3 distribution of base operating and equalization grants to
4 qualifying public community colleges and the City Colleges of
5 Chicago for educational related expenses.

6 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
8 Community College Board for all costs associated with career
9 and technical education activities:

10 From the General Revenue Fund17,569,400

11 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much of
12 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and
13 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community
14 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

15 From the General Revenue Fund:

3 ARTICLE 998

4 Section 998. The appropriation authority granted in this
5 Act shall be valid only for costs incurred July 1, 2015 to
6 June 30, 2016.

7 ARTICLE 999

8 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
9 becoming law.".
