1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2054

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2054, by deleting  
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the  
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The sum of \$5,472,188,200, is appropriated  
7 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of  
8 Education for payments to entities eligible for General State  
9 Aid as provided in the following amounts and the following  
10 order of priority: (i) an amount equal to the total amount  
11 appropriated for General State Aid for the 2015-2016 school  
12 year shall be paid to eligible entities in accordance with  
13 the provisions of Section 18-8.05 of the School Code as in  
14 effect for the 2015-2016 school year plus, when applicable,

1 the amounts paid from the appropriation contained in Section  
2 10 of Article 1 of Public Act 99-5 in accordance with the  
3 provisions of that Section as in effect for the 2015-2016  
4 school year, plus an amount equal to payments made in  
5 accordance with the provisions of Section 5/2-3.33 of the  
6 School Code; (ii) an Equity Grant, which shall be an amount  
7 equal to the product of \$700,000,000, multiplied by a  
8 fraction, the numerator of which is the amount of  
9 Supplemental General State Aid grant for that entity for the  
10 2015-2016 school year, and the denominator of which is the  
11 aggregate amount of all Supplemental General State Aid grants  
12 for all entities for the 2015-2016 school year; (iii) an  
13 amount necessary to ensure all eligible entities receive no  
14 less than their General State Aid claim for the 2016-2017  
15 school year, after the amounts paid under items (i) and (ii)  
16 of this Section; and (iv) any remaining amounts shall be  
17 provided to fund General State Aid payments calculated in  
18 accordance with the provisions of Section 18-8.05 of the  
19 School Code plus an amount equal to payments made in  
20 accordance with the provisions of Section 5/2-3.33 of the  
21 School Code, but only after subtracting the amounts provided  
22 to eligible entities pursuant to items (i), (ii), and (iii)  
23 of this Section.

24 Section 10. The following amounts, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State  
 2 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and  
 3 not, under any circumstances, for personal services  
 4 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,  
 5 are appropriated for Disabled Student Personnel Reimbursement  
 6 to the Illinois State Board of Education:

8 Section 15. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
 9 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State  
 10 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and  
 11 not, under any circumstances, for personal services  
 12 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,  
 13 are appropriated for Disabled Student Transportation  
 14 Reimbursement to the Illinois State Board of Education:

15 Payable from General Revenue Fund.....\$450,500,000

16 Section 20. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
 17 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State  
 18 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and  
 19 not, under any circumstances, for personal services  
 20 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,  
 21 are appropriated for Extraordinary Funding for Children  
 22 Requiring Special Education,14-7.02b of the School Code, to  
 23 the Illinois State Board of Education:

1 Payable from General Revenue Fund.....\$303,829,700

2 Section 25. The amount of \$23,380,900, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
4 Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education to meet  
5 its operational expenses, including prior year costs.

 11 Health Services.

12 Section 70. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof  
 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal  
 14 Agency Services Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education  
 15 for all costs associated with Adolescent Health Programs.

16 Section 75. The amount of \$5,600,000, or so much thereof  
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal  
 18 Agency Services Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education  
 19 for all costs associated with Abstinence Education Grants.

1           Section 5. The amount of \$12,186,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement  
4 Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for retirement  
5 contributions under Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension  
6 Code.

7           Section 10. The amount of \$100,000,000, or so much  
8 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
9 Revenue Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and  
10 Retirement Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for  
11 retirement contributions.

13           Section 15. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of  
16 Illinois for additional costs due to the establishment of  
17 minimum retirement allowances pursuant to Sections 16-136.2  
18 and 16-136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code, as amended.

19           Section 20. The sum of \$130,000, or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund  
21 to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer  
22 contributions required by the State as an employer of

1 teachers described under subsection (e) of Section 16-158 of  
2 the Illinois Pension Code.

3 Section 25. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund  
5 to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer  
6 contributions required by the State as an employer of  
7 teachers described under subsection (f) of Section 16-158 of  
8 the Illinois Pension Code.

9 ARTICLE 997

10 Section 997. All appropriation authority granted in this  
11 Act shall be used only for costs for services for which  
12 spending authority has not been authorized for fiscal years  
13 2016 or 2017 by any order of any court.

14 ARTICLE 999

15 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
16 1, 2016."
