SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.24 105 ILCS 25/1.20 new from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.24

Amends the School Code and the Interscholastic Athletic Organization Act. Provides that provisions allowing part-time attendance in the regular education program of a school district by pupils enrolled in nonpublic schools shall include allowing resident pupils who are enrolled in nonpublic schools to participate in those school-sponsored or school-supported athletic or extracurricular activities that are not selective with respect to who may join or participate. Requires an association or other entity that has as one of its purposes promoting, sponsoring, regulating, or in any manner providing for interscholastic athletics or any form of athletic competition among elementary or secondary schools and students within this State to report, on or before July 1, 2016, to the General Assembly on the association's or entity's efforts to communicate its rules to public and nonpublic schools in this State. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
10-20.24 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.24) (from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.24)

7 10-20.24. Part-time Attendance. Sec. То accept in 8 part-time attendance in the regular education program of the 9 district pupils enrolled in nonpublic schools if there is sufficient space in the public school desired to be attended. 10 For the purposes of this Section, allowing part-time attendance 11 12 in the regular education program of the district shall include allowing resident pupils who are enrolled in nonpublic schools 13 14 to participate in those school-sponsored or school-supported athletic or extracurricular activities that are not selective 15 16 with respect to who may join or participate. Request for attendance in the following school year must be submitted by 17 the nonpublic school principal to the public school before May 18 19 1. Request may be made only to those public schools located in the district where the child attending the nonpublic school 20 21 resides.
