8	part-time attendance in the regular education program of the

11	For the purposes of this Section, for 5 years from the
12	effective date of this amendatory Act of the 99th General
13	Assembly, allowing part-time attendance in the regular
14	education program of the district shall include allowing
15	resident pupils who are enrolled in nonpublic elementary
16	schools to participate in those school-sponsored or

1 school-supported athletic or extracurricular activities that are not selective with respect to who may join or participate, 2 in which case the district may submit a report to the State 3 4 Board of Education on the cost of having the nonpublic school 5 students participate. Request for attendance in the following 6 school year must be submitted by the nonpublic school principal to the public school before May 1. Request may be made only to 7 those public schools located in the district where the child 8 9 attending the nonpublic school resides.

To accept, pursuant to the provisions of Section 14-6.01, in part-time attendance resident pupils of the types described in Sections 14-1.02 through 14-1.07 who are enrolled in nonpublic schools.
