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AN ACT concerning health.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act is 5 amended by changing Section 2.36 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 620/2.36) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 502.36)

7 Sec. 2.36. "Prescription" means and and includes any order for drugs or medical devices, written, facsimile, or verbal by 8 9 a physician licensed to practice medicine in all its branches, 10 dentist, veterinarian, or podiatric physician containing the following: (1) name of the patient; (2) date when prescription 11 was given; (3) name and strength of drug or description of the 12 medical device prescribed; (4) quantity, (5) directions for 13 14 use, (6) prescriber's name, address and signature, and (7) DEA number where required, for controlled substances. 15
