A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Probate Act of 1975 is amended by changing
5 Section 27-6 as follows:

6 (755 ILCS 5/27-6) (from Ch. 110 1/2, par. 27-6)

7 Sec. 27-6. Actions which survive.) In addition to the
8 actions which survive by the common law, the following also
9 survive: actions of replevin, actions to recover damages for an
10 injury to the person (except slander and libel), actions to
11 recover damages for an injury to real or personal property or
12 for the detention or conversion of personal property, actions
13 against officers for misfeasance, malfeasance, nonfeasance of
14 themselves or their deputies, actions for fraud or deceit, and
15 actions provided in Section 6-21 of "An Act relating to
16 alcoholic liquors". A claim for punitive damages survives in an
17 action that survives under this Section.
