1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2536

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2536 as follows:

3 on page 2, immediately below line 7, by inserting the  
4 following:

5 "(b) No later than September 30, 2016, the Department shall  
6 provide mandatory annual trainings covering health and safety  
7 matters appropriate to a home-based setting for non-relative  
8 providers in the child care assistance program. Non-relative  
9 providers shall be paid \$15 per hour for their attendance and  
10 time spent at mandatory annual trainings. There shall be no  
11 charge for non-relative providers to attend mandatory annual  
12 trainings. Relative providers shall be encouraged, but not  
13 required, to attend mandatory annual trainings, and shall be  
14 paid \$15 per hour for their attendance and time spent at  
15 mandatory annual trainings.

16 Trainings shall be offered in person in each service  
17 delivery area. The Department shall provide mandatory annual

1 trainings in reasonably convenient locations, and at  
2 reasonable dates and times, and shall provide reasonable  
3 advance notice of available mandatory trainings to providers.  
4 The Department and the collective bargaining representative of  
5 the providers shall discuss the locations and schedules for  
6 mandatory annual trainings and notice to providers. Providers  
7 may complete no more than 50% of mandatory annual training  
8 hours online."; and

9 on page 2, line 8, by replacing "(b)" with "(c)".
