SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 20/9

from Ch. 111, par. 6359

Amends the Clinical Social Work and Social Work Practice Act. Requires an applicant for a clinical social worker license to hold a license as a social worker when completing the required clinical experience.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Clinical Social Work and Social Work

 Practice Act is amended by changing Section 9 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 20/9) (from Ch. 111, par. 6359)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018)
- Sec. 9. Qualification for clinical social worker license. A
 person shall be qualified to be licensed as a clinical social
 worker and the Department shall issue a license authorizing the
 independent practice of clinical social work to an applicant
- 12 who:
- 13 (1) has applied in writing on the prescribed form;
- (2) is of good moral character. In determining good moral character, the Department may take into consideration whether the applicant was engaged in conduct or actions that would constitute grounds for discipline under this Act;
- (3) (A) demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Department 18 19 that subsequent to securing a master's degree in social 20 from approved program the applicant an successfully completed 21 least 3,000 at hours of 22 satisfactory, supervised clinical professional experience
- 23 <u>while holding a license as a social worker;</u> or

2	that such applicant has received a doctor's degree in
3	social work from an approved program and has completed at
4	least 2,000 hours of satisfactory, supervised clinical
5	professional experience while holding a license as a social
5	worker subsequent to the degree;

- (4) has passed the examination for the practice of clinical social work as authorized by the Department; and
- 9 (5) has paid the required fees.
