1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2814

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2814, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 3 as follows:

5 on page 56, immediately below line 12, by inserting the
6 following:

7 "As used in this subsection (b), "low-income households"
8 means persons and families whose income does not exceed 80% of
9 area median income, adjusted for family size and revised every
10 5 years."; and

11 on page 77, line 21, by replacing "120" with "160"; and

12 on page 87, line 10, by replacing "120" with "160"; and

13 on page 177, line 8, before the period, by inserting "and
14 provided that such increase shall also incorporate reductions

1 to goals and budgets to reflect the proportion of the utility's
2 load attributable to customers who are exempt from this Section
3 under subsection (m) of this Section"; and

4 on page 178, immediately below line 5, by inserting the
5 following:

6 "(m) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, after May
7 31, 2017, this Section does not apply to any retail customers
8 of an electric utility that serves more than 3,000,000 retail
9 customers in the State and whose total highest 30 minute demand
10 was more than 10,000 kilowatts, or any retail customers of an
11 electric utility that serves less than 3,000,000 retail
12 customers but more than 500,000 retail customers in the State
13 and whose total highest 15 minute demand was more than 10,000
14 kilowatts. For purposes of this subsection (m), "retail
15 customer" has the meaning set forth in Section 16-102 of this
16 Act. The criteria for determining whether this subsection (m)
17 is applicable to a retail customer shall be based on the 12
18 consecutive billing periods prior to the start of the first
19 year of each such multi-year plan."; and

20 on page 386, line 14, by replacing "\$1,000,000" with
21 "\$500,000".
