Amend Senate Bill 2814, AS AMENDED, 2 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 3 4 3 as follows: on page 56, immediately below line 12, by inserting the 5 6 following: 7 "As used in this subsection (b), "low-income households" means persons and families whose income does not exceed 80% of 8 area median income, adjusted for family size and revised every 9 5 years."; and 10 11 on page 77, line 21, by replacing "120" with "160"; and 12 on page 87, line 10, by replacing "120" with "160"; and 13 on page 177, line 8, before the period, by inserting "__ provided that such increase shall also incorporate reductions 14

- to goals and budgets to reflect the proportion of the utility's 1
- 2 load attributable to customers who are exempt from this Section
- under subsection (m) of this Section"; and 3
- 4 on page 178, immediately below line 5, by inserting the
- 5 following:
- "(m) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, after May 6
- 31, 2017, this Section does not apply to any retail customers 7
- 8 of an electric utility that serves more than 3,000,000 retail
- 9 customers in the State and whose total highest 30 minute demand
- was more than 10,000 kilowatts, or any retail customers of an 10
- electric utility that serves less than 3,000,000 retail 11
- 12 customers but more than 500,000 retail customers in the State
- 13 and whose total highest 15 minute demand was more than 10,000
- 14 kilowatts. For purposes of this subsection (m), "retail
- customer" has the meaning set forth in Section 16-102 of this 15
- Act. The criteria for determining whether this subsection (m) 16
- is applicable to a retail customer shall be based on the 12 17
- consecutive billing periods prior to the start of the first 18
- 19 year of each such multi-year plan."; and

- "\$500,000". 21
