

99TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2015 and 2016 SB2846

Introduced 2/17/2016, by Sen. Ira I. Silverstein

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/4.3b new

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that it is unlawful for any person subject to the jurisdiction of this State to import animal trophies into, or export the trophy from, this State; take any trophy within this State; possess, sell, deliver, carry, transport, or ship by any means whatsoever any trophy in violation of specified provisions of the Act; deliver, receive, carry, transport, or ship in interstate or foreign commerce, by any means whatsoever and in the course of a commercial activity, any trophy; or sell or offer for sale in interstate or foreign commerce any trophy. Provides that the prohibition on import of animal trophies shall not apply when the import is expressly authorized by federal license or permit. Provides that the Department of Natural Resources may permit the import, sale of, offer for sale of, purchase of, barter of, or possession with intent to sell any trophy for bona fide educational or scientific purposes, unless this activity is prohibited by federal law.

1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section 4.3b as follows:

- 8 (a) As used in this Section:
- 9 "Trophy" means any whole or portion of any animal carcass that is (1) taken in violation of international law 10 or the United States Endangered Species Act, (2) listed as 11 12 endangered or threatened under the United States Endangered Species Act, or (3) proposed for consideration 13 14 to be listed as endangered or threatened under the United States Endangered Species Act, until the animal is removed 15 16 from the listing, the proposal for the listing is rejected or withdrawn, or it is otherwise lawful to take the animal. 17 (b) It shall be unlawful for any person subject to the 18

13	upon any other evidence which may serve to independently										
14	establish that intent. The act of obtaining an appraisal of any										
15	trophy alone shall not constitute possession with intent to

17	(d) A person may convey a trophy to a legal beneficiary if										
18	the trophy is part of an estate or other items being conveyed										
19	to lawful beneficiaries upon the death of the owner of the										
20	trophy or in anticipation of that death.										
21	(e) None of the prohibitions set forth in this Section										
22	shall apply to employees or agents of the federal or State										
23	government undertaking any law enforcement activities under

(g) The Department may permit, under terms and conditions as the Agency may prescribe, the import of, sale of, offer for sale of, purchase of, barter of, or possession with intent to sell any trophy for bona fide educational or scientific purposes, unless this activity is prohibited by federal law.
