### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/7-155

from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 7-155

Amends the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Deletes the one-year limit on backdating a survivor benefit. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing
Section 7-155 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/7-155) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 7-155)

Sec. 7-155. Surviving spouse annuities-commencement. A surviving spouse annuity shall begin on the 1st day of the month next following the month in which the participating employee, or the employee annuitant or such person entitled to a retirement annuity died, upon a written application therefor, provided:

<u>(Blank).</u> Such date is not more than one year prior to
 the date the application was received by the Board; and

15 2. The amount of surviving spouse annuity before the 16 application of paragraph 3 of Section 7-158, is at least \$5 per 17 month, beginning on such date.
