

99TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2015 and 2016 SB2994

Introduced 2/18/2016, by Sen. Thomas Cullerton

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-44060 new

Amends the Counties Code. Provides that on or before January 1, 2017, every county shall prepare a report for the General Assembling recommending units of local government (not including school districts or units of local government with elected boards) that may be consolidated or dissolved within the county. Repeals these provisions on January 1, 2018. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning local government. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section 5 5-44060 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/5-44060 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-44060. Local government consolidation and 8 dissolution report.
- 9 (a) As used in this Section, "unit of local government" has the same meaning as defined in Section 1 of Article VII of the 10 Constitution of the State of Illinois but does not include any 11 12 unit of local government whose governing board is elected by
- 13 popular vote or school districts.

14 (b) On or before January 1, 2017, the county board or board of commissioners of each county shall prepare and file a report 15 16 with the General Assembly with the board's recommendations as to which units of local government, fully or partly in their 17 county, should be consolidated or dissolved. The report shall 18 19 include, but is not limited to, each of the following concerning each unit of local government that the board is 20 21 recommending to be consolidated or dissolved: (1) the name of 22 the unit of local government; (2) the principal place of business of the unit of local government; (3) what types of

- 1 services the unit of local government provides; (4) why the
- 2 <u>board</u> believes the unit of local government should be
- 3 consolidated or dissolved; and (5) a recommendation on how the
- 4 unit of local government should be consolidated or dissolved.
- 5 (c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2018.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
