9	(a) As used in this Section,	"local public entity" shall
10	mean any unit of local government,	special district, or other
11	governing body whose membership i	s appointed in whole or in
12	part by the county board, board of county commissioners, county	
13	board chairman or president, or county executive.	
14	(b) On or before January 1, 201	7, the county board or board
15	of county commissioners of each cou	nty shall prepare and file a
16	report with the General Assembly i	dentifying any local public

entity that the county board, board of county commissioners, 1 county board chairman or president, or county executive 2 3 appoints members to. The report shall include, but is not 4 limited to, the following concerning each local public entity: 5 (1) the legal name of the local public entity; (2) the principal place of business of the local public entity; (3) a 6 description of the services the local public entity provides; 7 (4) the total numbers of members of the local public entity's 8 9 governing board, with an indication of any other authorities 10 that also make appointments to that public entity; (5) the 11 process by which the local public entity was first created; (6) an identification of any plans for consolidation or dissolution 12 of the local public entity; (7) an indication of whether or not 13 the local public entity levies a property tax; and (8) if there 14 15 is no property tax levy, an explanation of how the local public 16 entity is funded.

(c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2018.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 18 19 becoming law.".
