1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3018

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 3018 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
5 changing Sections 1-118, 3-107, and 3-406 and by adding Section  
6 1-123.8 as follows:

7 (625 ILCS 5/1-118) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-118)

8 Sec. 1-118. Essential Parts. All integral and body parts of  
9 a vehicle of a type required to be registered hereunder, the  
10 removal, alteration or substitution of which would tend to  
11 conceal the identity of the vehicle or substantially alter its  
12 appearance, model, type or mode of operation. "Essential parts"  
13 includes the following: vehicle hulks, shells, chassis,  
14 frames, front end assemblies (which may consist of headlight,  
15 grill, fenders and hood), front clip (front end assembly with  
16 cowl attached), rear clip (which may consist of quarter panels,

1 fenders, floor and top), doors, hatchbacks, fenders, cabs, cab  
2 clips, cowls, hoods, trunk lids, deck lids, T-tops, sunroofs,  
3 moon roofs, astro roofs, transmissions of vehicles of the  
4 second division, seats, aluminum wheels, engines and similar  
5 parts. Essential parts shall also include stereo radios,  
6 cassette radios, compact disc radios, cassette/compact disc  
7 radios and compact disc players and compact disc changers which  
8 are either installed in dash or trunk-mounted.

9 An essential part which does not have affixed to it an  
10 identification number as defined in Section 1-129 adopts the  
11 identification number of the vehicle to which such part is  
12 affixed, installed or mounted.

13 An "essential part" does not include an engine,  
14 transmission, or a rear axle that is used in a glider kit.

16 (625 ILCS 5/1-123.8 new)

17 Sec. 1-123.8. Glider kit. A motor vehicle of the second  
18 division that includes a chassis, cab, front axle, and other  
19 essential parts, except for an engine, transmission, or rear  
20 axle.

21 (625 ILCS 5/3-107) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-107)

22 Sec. 3-107. Contents and effect.

23 (a) Each certificate of title issued by the Secretary of  
24 State shall contain:

- 1           1. the date issued;
- 2           2. the name and address of the owner;
- 3           3. the names and addresses of any lienholders, in the
- 4           order of priority as shown on the application or, if the
- 5           application is based on a certificate of title, as shown on
- 6           the certificate;
- 7           4. the title number assigned to the vehicle;
- 8           5. a description of the vehicle including, so far as
- 9           the following data exists: its make, year-model,
- 10          identifying number, type of body, whether new or used, as
- 11          to house trailers as defined in Section 1-128 of this Code,
- 12          and as to manufactured homes as defined in Section 1-144.03
- 13          of this Code, the square footage of the vehicle based upon
- 14          the outside dimensions excluding the length of the tongue
- 15          and hitch, and, if a new vehicle, the date of the first
- 16          sale of the vehicle for use;
- 17          6. an odometer certification as provided for in this
- 18          Code; and
- 19          7. any other data the Secretary of State prescribes.

20           (a-5) In the event the applicant seeks to have the vehicle  
21          titled as a custom vehicle or street rod, that fact must be  
22          stated in the application. The custom vehicle or street rod  
23          must be inspected as required by Section 3-406 of this Code  
24          prior to issuance of the title. Upon successful completion of  
25          the inspection, the vehicle may be titled in the following  
26          manner. The make of the vehicle shall be listed as the make of

1 the actual vehicle or the make it is designed to resemble  
2 (e.g., Ford or Chevrolet); the model of the vehicle shall be  
3 listed as custom vehicle or street rod; and the year of the  
4 vehicle shall be listed as the year the actual vehicle was  
5 manufactured or the year it is designed to resemble. A vehicle  
6 previously titled as other than a custom vehicle or street rod  
7 may be issued a corrected title reflecting the custom vehicle  
8 or street rod model if it otherwise meets the requirements for  
9 the designation.

10 (a-10) In the event the applicant seeks to have the vehicle  
11 titled as a glider kit, that fact must be stated in the  
12 application. The glider kit must be inspected under Section  
13 3-406 of this Code prior to issuance of the title. Upon  
14 successful completion of the inspection, the vehicle shall be  
15 titled in the following manner: (1) the make of the vehicle  
16 shall be listed as the make of the chassis or the make it is  
17 designed to resemble; (2) the model of the vehicle shall be  
18 listed as glider kit; and (3) the year of the vehicle shall be  
19 listed as the year presented on the manufacturer's certificate  
20 of origin for the chassis, unless no year is presented, then it  
21 shall be listed as the year the application was received. The  
22 vehicle identification number of the chassis shall be assigned  
23 to the engine, transmission, and rear axle if the engine,  
24 transmission, and rear axle were not previously assigned a  
25 vehicle identification number after an inspection under  
26 Section 3-406.

1           (b) The certificate of title shall contain forms for  
2 assignment and warranty of title by the owner, and for  
3 assignment and warranty of title by a dealer, and may contain  
4 forms for applications for a certificate of title by a  
5 transferee, the naming of a lienholder and the assignment or  
6 release of the security interest of a lienholder.

7           (b-5) The Secretary of State shall designate on a  
8 certificate of title a space where the owner of a vehicle may  
9 designate a beneficiary, to whom ownership of the vehicle shall  
10 pass in the event of the owner's death.

11           (c) A certificate of title issued by the Secretary of State  
12 is prima facie evidence of the facts appearing on it.

13           (d) A certificate of title for a vehicle is not subject to  
14 garnishment, attachment, execution or other judicial process,  
15 but this subsection does not prevent a lawful levy upon the  
16 vehicle.

17           (e) Any certificate of title issued by the Secretary of  
18 State is subject to a lien in favor of the State of Illinois  
19 for any fees or taxes required to be paid under this Act and as  
20 have not been paid, as provided for in this Code.

21           (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a  
22 certificate of title issued by the Secretary of State to a  
23 manufactured home is prima facie evidence of the facts  
24 appearing on it, notwithstanding the fact that such  
25 manufactured home, at any time, shall have become affixed in  
26 any manner to real property.

2 (625 ILCS 5/3-406) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-406)

3 Sec. 3-406. Application for specially constructed,  
4 reconstructed, custom, street rod, ~~or~~ foreign vehicles, or  
5 glider kits.

6 (a) In the event the vehicle to be registered is a  
7 specially constructed, reconstructed or foreign vehicle, such  
8 fact shall be stated in the application and with reference to  
9 every foreign vehicle which has been registered heretofore  
10 outside of this State the owner shall surrender to the  
11 Secretary of State all registration plates, registration cards  
12 or other evidence of such foreign registration as may be in his  
13 possession or under his control except as provided in  
14 subdivision (b) hereof.

15 (b) Where in the course of interstate operation of a  
16 vehicle registered in another State, it is desirable to retain  
17 registration of said vehicle in such other State, such  
18 applicant need not surrender but shall submit for inspection  
19 said evidences of such foreign registration and the Secretary  
20 of State upon a proper showing shall register said vehicle in  
21 this State but shall not issue a certificate of title for such  
22 vehicle.

23 (c) In the event the applicant seeks to have the vehicle  
24 registered as a custom vehicle or street rod, that fact must be  
25 stated in the application. Prior to registration, custom

1 vehicles or street rods must be inspected by the Secretary of  
2 State Department of Police. Upon successful completion of the  
3 inspection, the vehicle may be registered in the following  
4 manner. The make of the vehicle shall be listed as the make of  
5 the actual vehicle or the make it is designed to resemble  
6 (e.g., Ford or Chevrolet); the model of the vehicle shall be  
7 listed as custom vehicle or street rod; and the year of the  
8 vehicle shall be listed as the year the actual vehicle was  
9 manufactured or the year it is designed to resemble.

10 (d) In the event the applicant seeks to have the vehicle  
11 registered as a glider kit, that fact must be stated in the  
12 application. Each glider kit sought to be registered shall be  
13 inspected by the Secretary of State Department of Police who  
14 shall verify the chassis, cab, front axle, and other essential  
15 parts as acceptable. Upon successful completion of the  
16 inspection, the vehicle may be registered in the following  
17 manner: (1) the make of the vehicle shall be listed as the make  
18 of the chassis of the actual manufacturer; (2) the model of the  
19 vehicle shall be listed as glider kit; and (3) the year of the  
20 vehicle shall be listed as the year presented on the  
21 manufacturer's certificate of origin for the chassis, unless no  
22 year is presented, then it shall be listed as the year the  
23 application is received.
