1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3025

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3025 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
5 adding Section 11-6-9 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/11-6-9 new)

7 Sec. 11-6-9. Purchase of tires under joint purchasing
8 authority.

9 (a) If authorized by the fire chief of the fire department,
10 any regularly enrolled volunteer firefighter may purchase 4
11 vehicle tires every 3 years through his or her fire
12 department's or municipality's contract to purchase vehicle
13 tires under Section 2 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act.
14 The authorization must be in writing and on the fire
15 department's letterhead, and must include the volunteer
16 firefighter's name, the license plate number of the vehicle for

1 the authorized purchase, and must reference the fire
2 department's or municipality's joint purchasing agreement. For
3 purposes of this Section only, "vehicle" has the meaning
4 provided in Section 1-146 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

5 (b) The fire department or municipality shall alone be
6 responsible for documenting how many tires each volunteer
7 firefighter purchases during the specified periods under this
8 Section.

9 (c) The firefighter shall pay for any tires, and any
10 related taxes, purchased under this Section.

11 (d) Purchase of tires under this Section are not considered
12 tax exempt.

13 (e) This Section applies to contracts first solicited under
14 Section 4 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act on or after
15 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 99th General
16 Assembly.

17 Section 10. The Fire Protection District Act is amended by
18 adding Section 10d as follows:

19 (70 ILCS 705/10d new)

20 Sec. 10d. Purchase of tires under joint purchasing
21 authority.

22 (a) If authorized by the fire chief of the fire protection
23 district, any regularly enrolled volunteer firefighter may
24 purchase 4 vehicle tires every 3 years through his or her fire

1 protection district's contract to purchase vehicle tires under
2 Section 2 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act. The
3 authorization must be in writing and on the fire protection
4 district's letterhead, and must include the volunteer
5 firefighter's name, the license plate number of the vehicle for
6 the authorized purchase, and must reference the fire protection
7 district's joint purchasing agreement. For purposes of this
8 Section only, "vehicle" has the meaning provided in Section
9 1-146 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

10 (b) The fire protection district shall alone be responsible
11 for documenting how many tires each volunteer firefighter
12 purchases during the specified period under this Section.

13 (c) The firefighter shall pay for any tires, and any
14 related taxes, purchased under this Section.

15 (d) Purchase of tires under this Section are not considered
16 tax exempt.

17 (e) This Section applies to contracts first solicited under
18 Section 4 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act on or after
19 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 99th General
20 Assembly.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
22 becoming law."
