SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 50/2

from Ch. 144, par. 61.52

Amends the Municipal Clerk Training Act. Provides that at least one (currently, one) ex-officio member designated by the governing board of any public college or university shall be on the Municipal Clerk Training Institute Committee. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Municipal Clerk Training Act is amended by
5 changing Section 2 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 50/2) (from Ch. 144, par. 61.52)

7 Sec. 2. There is created the Municipal Clerk Training
8 Institute Committee composed of 5 municipal clerks or deputy
9 clerks, appointed by the Governor as provided herein, and at
10 least one ex-officio member designated by the governing board
11 of any public college or university in this State at the
12 request of the Executive Board of the Municipal Clerks of
13 Illinois as a representative of public colleges and
14 universities in this State. Each member appointed by the
15 Governor after the effective date of this amendatory Act of
16 1987 shall be a certified municipal clerk recommended by the
17 Executive Board of the Municipal Clerks of Illinois and serving
18 as a municipal clerk at the time he or she is so recommended
19 and appointed. Each successor of any member appointed to the
20 Committee as a municipal clerk or deputy clerk shall be
21 appointed to serve for a 4 year term expiring on the third
22 Monday in January, or until his or her successor is appointed
23 and qualified. Any vacancy occurring in the office of a

1 Committee member appointed by the Governor, whether by death,
2 resignation or otherwise, shall be filled by appointment by the
3 Governor from a recommendation or recommendations made by the
4 Executive Board of the Municipal Clerks of Illinois, in the
5 same manner as original appointments. A member appointed to
6 fill a vacancy shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired
7 term or until his or her successor is appointed and qualified.
8 In the event the Governor refuses to appoint a municipal clerk
9 or deputy clerk recommended by the Executive Board of the
10 Municipal Clerks of Illinois to either a full term or, in cases
11 of a vacancy, to the remainder of an unexpired term on the
12 Committee, such Executive Board shall promptly recommend one or
13 more additional qualified persons to the Governor for such
14 appointment. The term of each ~~the~~ ex-officio member may be
15 designated by the governing board of any public college or
16 university in this State at the request of the Executive Board
17 of the Municipal Clerks of Illinois. Each ~~The~~ ex-officio member
18 representing the public colleges and universities shall serve
19 in an advisory capacity to the members appointed by the
20 Governor, and such ex-officio members ~~member~~ shall serve at the
21 pleasure of the governing board designating them to membership
22 on the Committee. Members of the Committee shall serve without
23 compensation.
