SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Insurance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, as follows:

- 5 Section 45. The sum of \$950,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 6
- 7 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of
- Insurance for costs associated with the administration and 8
- 9 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois
- 10 Workers' Compensation Commission's anti-fraud program.
- Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 11
- 12 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 13 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- 14 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
