1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

The following named amounts, or so much 5 Section 5. thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 6 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the 8 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet 9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending 10 June 30, 2017: 11 12 For State Contributions to Social 13 For Contractual Services320,600 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 Total 21 \$2,539,800

- 1 Section 10. The sum of \$404,000, or so much thereof as
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 3 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses
- 4 associated with the administration and enforcement associated
- 5 with the P-20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.
- 6 Section 15. The sum of \$115,000, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 8 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
- 9 with the Midwest Higher Education Compact.
- 10 Section 20. The sum of \$203,700, or so much thereof as
- 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 12 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
- 13 with the u.Select System.
- Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof
- 15 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General
- 16 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for
- 17 Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (S.T.E.M.)
- 18 diversity initiatives to enhance S.T.E.M. programs for
- 19 students from underrepresented groups:
- 20 Illinois Mathematics and Science
- 21 Academy Excellence 2000 Program

- Section 30. The sum of \$1,089,400, or so much thereof as 1
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 3 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
- grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of 4
- 5 higher education.
- Section 35. The sum of \$1,065,000, or so much thereof as 6
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 8 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the
- 9 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for
- 10 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.
- 11 Section 40. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof
- as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education 12
- 13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the
- 14 distribution of grants to public universities based
- 15 performance-based goals.
- 16 Section 45. The sum of \$30,000 or so much thereof as may
- 17 be necessary, is appropriated from the Distance Learning Fund
- 18 to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for
- 19 13 costs and expenses associated with the administration and
- 20 14 enforcement of 110 ILCS 145/40.

- 1 Section 50. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof
- 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic
- 3 Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as
- 4 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with
- 5 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.
- 6 Section 55. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College
- 8 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher
- 9 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses
- 10 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110
- 11 ILCS 1005.
- 12 Section 60. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business
- 14 and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of
- 15 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and
- 16 expenses associated with the administration and enforcement
- of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.
- 18 Section 65. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants
- 20 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under
- 21 the terms and conditions associated with the federal
- 22 contracts and grants moneys received.
