SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 170/15

Amends the First Informer Broadcasters Act. Provides that the Illinois Emergency Management Agency may by rule establish protocols to facilitate first informer access to affected areas.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The First Informer Broadcasters Act is amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

- Sec. 15. First informer broadcasters; training and certification.
 - (a) Any Statewide organization, or any member of a Statewide organization, that represents broadcasters, cable television communications, or any other provider that uses emerging technologies may establish a program for training and certifying broadcast engineers and technical personnel as first informer broadcasters. Each program established pursuant to this subsection must:
 - (i) be consistent with federal law and guidelines;
 - (ii) provide training and education concerning restoring, repairing and resupplying any facilities and equipment of a broadcaster in an area affected by an emergency or disaster; and
 - (iii) provide training and education concerning the personal safety of a first informer broadcaster in an area affected by an emergency or disaster.

- 1 (b) To the extent practicable and consistent with not 2 endangering public safety or inhibiting recovery efforts, 3 State and local governmental agencies shall allow a first 4 informer broadcaster access to an area affected by an emergency 5 or disaster for the purpose of restoring, repairing, or 6 resupplying any facility or equipment critical to the ability 7 of a broadcaster to acquire, produce, and transmit essential emergency or disaster-related public information programming, 8 9 including, without limitation, repairing and maintaining 10 transmitters and generators, and transporting fuel for 11 generators.
- 12 <u>(c) The Illinois Emergency Management Agency may by rule</u>
 13 <u>establish protocols to facilitate first informer access to</u>
 14 affected areas under this Section.
