Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning liability insurance.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 12-707.01 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/12-707.01) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-707.01)
7 Sec. 12-707.01. Liability insurance.

8 (a) No school bus, first division vehicle including a ~~a~~
9 taxi which is used for a purpose that requires a school bus
10 driver permit, commuter van or motor vehicle owned by or used
11 for hire by and in connection with the operation of private or
12 public schools, day camps, summer camps or nursery schools, and
13 no commuter van or passenger car used for a for-profit
14 ridesharing arrangement, shall be operated for such purposes
15 unless the owner thereof shall carry a minimum of personal
16 injury liability insurance in the amount of \$25,000 for any one
17 person in any one accident, and subject to the limit for one
18 person, \$100,000 for two or more persons injured by reason of
19 the operation of the vehicle in any one accident. This
20 subsection (a) applies only to personal injury liability
21 policies issued or renewed before January 1, 2013.

22 (b) Liability insurance policies issued or renewed on and
23 after January 1, 2013 shall comply with the following:

1 (1) except as provided in subparagraph (2) of this
2 subsection (b), any vehicle that is used for a purpose that
3 requires a school bus driver permit under Section 6-104 of
4 this Code shall carry a minimum of liability insurance in
5 the amount of \$2,000,000 combined single limit per
6 accident;

7 (2) any vehicle that is used for a purpose that
8 requires a school bus driver permit under Section 6-104 of
9 this Code and is used in connection with the operation of
10 private day care facilities, day camps, summer camps, or
11 nursery schools shall carry a minimum of liability
12 insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 combined single limit
13 per accident;

14 (3) any commuter van or passenger car used for a
15 for-profit ridesharing arrangement shall carry a minimum
16 of liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000 combined
17 single limit per accident.
