1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof as may  
6 be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter named,  
7 are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Grants-  
8 In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions pursuant to  
9 Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and the Community  
10 Mental Health Act:

11 MENTAL HEALTH GRANTS AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

12 GRANTS-IN-AID AND PURCHASED CARE

13 For all costs and administrative expenses for Community Service  
14 Programs for Persons with Mental Illness, Child and Adolescent  
15 Mental Health Programs, Community Hospital Inpatient &  
16 Psychiatric Services, Evaluation Determination, Disposition, &  
17 Assessment, Jail Data Link Project, Juvenile Justice Trauma  
18 Program, Psychiatrist Services, Regions Special Consumer  
19 Supports & Mental Health Services, Rural Behavioral Health  
20 Access, Supported Residential, the Living Room, and all other  
21 Non-Medicaid Services to persons with Mental Illness:

22 Payable from General Revenue Fund .....58,815,000

1 Section 10. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the  
 2 following named sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
 3 respectively, for the purposes hereinafter named, are  
 4 appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Grants-In-  
 5 Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions pursuant to  
 6 Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and the Community  
 7 Mental Health Act:

11 For costs associated with the Purchase and

 Balancing Incentive Programs .....7,843,900

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17 Section 15. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the  
 18 following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
 19 respectively, for the objects hereinafter named, are  
 20 appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Family and  
 21 Community Services and related distributive purposes, including  
 22 such Federal funds as are made available by the Federal  
 23 government for the following purposes:

1 ARTICLE 2

2 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
4 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and  
5 contingent expenses of the Department of Revenue:

6 PAYABLE FROM RENTAL HOUSING SUPPORT PROGRAM FUND

7 For administration of the Rental

8 Housing Support Program .....1,600,000

9 For current and all prior years' costs

10 of rental assistance to the Rental

11 Housing Support Program, administered

12 by the Illinois Housing Development Authority.....43,000,000

13 Total \$44,600,000

14 PAYABLE FROM ILLINOIS AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND

15 For administration of the Illinois 10

16 Affordable Housing Act ..... 4,100,000

17 Section 20. The sum of \$65,000,000, or so much thereof as may  
18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Affordable  
19 Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for grants,  
20 (down payment assistance, rental subsidies, security deposit  
21 subsidies, technical assistance, outreach, building an  
22 organization's capacity to develop affordable housing projects  
23 and other related purposes), mortgages, loans, or for the

1 purpose of securing bonds pursuant to the Illinois Affordable  
2 Housing Act, administered by the Illinois Housing Development  
3 Authority.

4 Section 30. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may  
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Affordable  
6 Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for grants to  
7 other state agencies for rental assistance, supportive living  
8 and adaptive housing.

9 Section 35. The sum of \$25,000,000, new appropriation, is  
10 appropriated and the sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of  
12 business on June 30, 2015, from appropriations and  
13 reappropriations heretofore made in Article 35, Section 30 of  
14 Public Act 98-0679 is reappropriated from the Federal HOME  
15 Investment Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for the  
16 Illinois HOME Investment Partnerships Program administered by  
17 the Illinois Housing Development Authority.

18 Section 40. The sum of \$8,500,000, or so much thereof as may  
19 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreclosure Prevention  
20 Program Fund to the Department of Revenue for administration by  
21 the Illinois Housing Development Authority, for grants and  
22 administrative expenses pursuant to the Foreclosure Prevention

1 Program.

2 Section 45. The sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as may  
3 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreclosure Prevention  
4 Program Graduated Fund to the Department of Revenue for  
5 administration by the Illinois Housing Development Authority,  
6 for grants and administrative expenses pursuant to the  
7 Foreclosure Prevention Program.

8 Section 50. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof as may  
9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Abandoned Residential  
10 Property Municipality Relief Fund to the Department of Revenue  
11 for administration by the Illinois Housing Development  
12 Authority, for grants and administrative expenses pursuant to  
13 the Abandoned Residential Property Municipality Relief Program.

14 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this  
15 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through  
16 June 30, 2016.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect  
18 immediately.
