SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates FY 16 funding to various mental health and homeless assistance programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 30. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may
- 5 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Affordable
- 6 Housing Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for grants to
- 7 other state agencies for rental assistance, supportive living
- 8 and adaptive housing.
- 9 Section 35. The sum of \$25,000,000, new appropriation, is
- appropriated and the sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 11 may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of
- 12 business on June 30, 2015, from appropriations and
- 13 reappropriations heretofore made in Article 35, Section 30 of
- 14 Public Act 98-0679 is reappropriated from the Federal HOME
- 15 Investment Trust Fund to the Department of Revenue for the
- 16 Illinois HOME Investment Partnerships Program administered by
- 17 the Illinois Housing Development Authority.
- 18 Section 40. The sum of \$8,500,000, or so much thereof as may
- 19 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreclosure Prevention
- 20 Program Fund to the Department of Revenue for administration by
- 21 the Illinois Housing Development Authority, for grants and
- 22 administrative expenses pursuant to the Foreclosure Prevention

- 1 Program.
- 2 Section 45. The sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as may
- 3 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreclosure Prevention
- 4 Program Graduated Fund to the Department of Revenue for
- 5 administration by the Illinois Housing Development Authority,
- 6 for grants and administrative expenses pursuant to the
- 7 Foreclosure Prevention Program.
- 8 Section 50. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof as may
- 9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Abandoned Residential
- 10 Property Municipality Relief Fund to the Department of Revenue
- 11 for administration by the Illinois Housing Development
- 12 Authority, for grants and administrative expenses pursuant to
- 13 the Abandoned Residential Property Municipality Relief Program.
- 14 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this
- 15 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through
- 16 June 30, 2016.
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect
- 18 immediately.
