1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, Invasive species come in many forms, from plants
- and animals to insects and diseases; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Invasive species can greatly harm the ecology and
- 5 economy of the State of Illinois; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Invasive species can reduce productivity of
- 7 agricultural lands, impact diversity of natural systems,
- 8 reduce wildlife habitat, and limit recreational activities;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois faces many challenges with
- invasive plants and animals; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Illinois can make a significant difference in
- 13 battling invasive species, whether through cleaning water
- 14 craft, volunteering at workdays, choosing to purchase species
- 15 that are not considered invasive, knowing proper disposal
- 16 methods for bait and unwanted aquarium pets or plants, or
- 17 controlling invasive species on their lands; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The public's awareness and participation is key to
- 19 reducing and eliminating invasive species in Illinois; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has a longstanding
- 2 commitment to its natural heritage; therefore, be it
- 3 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL
- 4 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 5 CONCURRING HEREIN, that we show our support for Illinois
- 6 Invasive Species Awareness Month, which states that
- 7 organizations, agencies, and groups across Illinois will team
- 8 up each year up to organize events that raise awareness of the
- 9 negative impacts of invasive species on Illinois' landscape and
- 10 economy; and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That we designate the month of May in 2015 and
- 12 2016 as Invasive Species Awareness Month in the State of
- 13 Illinois in furtherance of our support of this important
- 14 initiative.
