8 WHEREAS, There is both a financial and an environmental 9 cost for producing plastic driver's licenses; and

12 WHEREAS, The States of Iowa and Delaware are planning to 13 experiment with digital licenses in 2015; and

14 WHEREAS, The digital driver's license would be optional and 15 not required; therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL 17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 18 CONCURRING HEREIN, that we urge the Secretary of State to study 19 and consider the issuance of optional digital driver's licenses SJ0010 -2- LRB099 09042 GRL 29229 r 1 for Illinois motorists; and be it further
