| 4  | "WHEREAS, Illinois has more units of local government than      |
| 5  | any state in the country, numbered at over 7,000; and           |
| 6  | WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that consolidation of       |
| 7  | units of local government will result in cost-saving for the    |
| 8  | taxpayers; and  |
| 9  | WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that consolidation of       |
| 10 | units of local government shall only occur with no reduction in |
| 11 | the quality of service to taxpayers; and                        |
| 12 | WHEREAS, Lake County and the 31st Legislative District          |
| 13 | would benefit from a study assessing how specific units of      |

local government may be consolidated or dissolved; therefore,

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- 2 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL 3 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 4 CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Working Group on Local Government Consolidation is created to identify ways to eliminate barriers 5 to consolidation and resolve certain discrepancies in the 6 7 Illinois statutes governing local governments and special 8 districts in Lake County and the 31st Legislative District; and 9 be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, The Working Group shall consist of the following
  11 members:
- 12 (1) one member of the Senate appointed by the President 13 of the Senate, who shall serve as chair;
  - (2) one member of the Senate appointed by the Senate Minority Leader;
  - (3) one member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House;
  - (4) one member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Minority Leader of the House;
    - (5) one member selected from recommendations provided by the Lake County Board appointed by the Governor;
    - (6) one member selected from recommendations provided by the Lake County Forest Preserve District appointed by the Governor:

RESOLVED, That Working Group shall submit their report to the General Assembly no later than October 1, 2016; the report shall include findings including, but not limited to, the following issues as they occur in Lake County:

- (1) an assessment of the number of units of local government and the costs associated with each unit, including salaries, expenses, and operating costs;
- (2) an assessment of the units of local government are engaged in intergovernmental cooperation efforts and what, if any, cost savings such partnerships have resulted in;
- (3) recommendations for the elimination of barriers to consolidation;
- (4) recommendations for the streamlining or consolidation of units of local government; and
- 19 (5) recommendations for intergovernmental cooperation 20 potential.".
