1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Senate Joint Resolution 11 of the 99th General
3 Assembly created the Electronic Driver's License Task Force to
4 examine and make recommendations related to the feasibility and
5 cost of the Secretary of State issuing electronic or "virtual"
6 driver's licenses to Illinois residents, in addition to
7 currently accepted forms of identification; and

8 WHEREAS, Senate Joint Resolution 11 further directed that
9 the findings of the Task Force be reported to the General
10 Assembly by December 31, 2015; this due date for the report is
11 no longer workable given the scope of the Task Force's
12 responsibilities; therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL
14 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
15 CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Electronic Driver's License Task
16 Force shall meet at least 3 times and shall issue a report of
17 its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly on or
18 before May 1, 2016; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That the Task Force is dissolved following the
20 filing of its report; and be it further

21 RESOLVED, That, with this reporting extension, the Task

1 Force shall continue to operate pursuant to Senate Joint
2 Resolution 11 of the 99th General Assembly.
