2 WHEREAS, There is a need to educate our youth of the 3 importance of protecting and conserving Illinois's precious 4 natural resources; and 5 WHEREAS, By combining in-class curriculum and hands-on 6 field experiences, the Envirothon program is an excellent way 7 to supplement environmental education inside and outside the traditional classroom; and 8 9 WHEREAS, The Envirothon is a hands-on environmental 10 problem-solving competition for high school-aged students in the United States and Canada; and 11 12 WHEREAS, The Envirothon works in partnership with local 13 conservation districts, forestry associations, educators, and cooperating natural resource agencies to organize and conduct 14 competitions on the local, regional, state, and/or provincial 15 16 level; and 17 WHEREAS, Illinois is an active participant in the 18 International Envirothon Competition; and 19 WHEREAS, Envirothon participants gain valuable knowledge

and training in ecology and natural resource management

- 1 principles, and practices, and the importance and limitations
- of soils, wildlife, aquatic ecosystems, forestry, and current
- 3 important environmental issues; and
- WHEREAS, The Illinois Envirothon has been responsible for
- 5 more than 18,000 participating high school students being
- 6 taught these important natural resource principles and issues
- 7 since 1995; and
- 8 WHEREAS, It is important that the citizens of Illinois
- 9 recognize the contributions of this event toward training our
- 10 youth to be responsible caretakers of the State's precious
- 11 natural resources; therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-NINTH GENERAL
- ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate April 30,
- 2015 and April 28, 2016 as Envirothon Day throughout Illinois
- 15 to bring recognition to the activities of the Envirothon
- 16 program.
